  caused considerable stress to residents in the vicinity, by its sheer ugliness
  and bad condition. Also we are informed it is seldom used.
- b) Bus Shelters owned by Leigh Town Council
  As the majority of shelters are in very poor condition and the style outdated,
  does the committee believe we should request Southend Borough Council
  to replace them on a rolling programme of 3 or 4 a year? With the most
  dilapidated first. Secondly existing shelters which are really an eyesore
  should we remove in the meantime? This may spur on Graham Newman to
  replace them even more urgently.
