  - a. **Visit to Hylands House** 36 members (3 minibuses, 6 drivers and escorts) visited Hylands House and grounds on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July. As the weather was not so good in the morning the trip was combined with a visit to Altons Garden Centre. Feedback from members indicated that the whole trip was thoroughly enjoyed including the guided tour of the House and the afternoon tea. Members said they would like a return visit, so that they could have lunch in the cafe and have more time to look round the gardens and small shop.
6. Progress on Arrangements made for Future Events:
  - a. **Tropical Wings**. Provisional booking not taken forward as replaced by the concert below.
  - b. **Help for Heroes Concert**, with the Band of the Welsh Guards, on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> September at Cliffs Pavilion. Despite initial enthusiasm from members ticket reservations have only been received from 14 people. One coach has been booked. A driver and helper have been arranged.
  - c. **The Secret Garden**, performed by the Leigh Operatic and Dramatic Society, on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> October at the Palace Theatre. 40 tickets have been reserved and bookings have been received from 29 members. Arrangements for minibuses, drivers and helpers have yet to be made.
  - d. **Southend Mencap Music School Christmas Concert**, on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December at Highlands Methodist Church. 32 Tickets have been reserved. Seats are not allocated. After the performance, which lasts approximately one hour fifteen minutes, tea, coffee, biscuits and mince pies will be served. This concert has not been circulated to our membership yet
