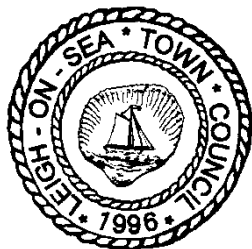

PUBLIC TRANSPORT REPRESENTATIVES REPORT

Arriva Bus Services

With effect from Sunday 19th February, every route (except one day per week Services 10 and 18) in SE Essex will have revised timetable.

Services affecting Leigh

Service 1 Sundays currently Southend to Rayleigh 1000 to 1700 ½ hourly - Southend to Hadleigh one hourly – Southend to Rayleigh – NEW all journeys 1000 to 1700 extended to and from Rayleigh

Service 5 Southend to Basildon via Leigh Broadway basic frequency 30 mins, but current departures from Southend 05 and 35 & Basildon 19 and 49
NEW Southend 17 and 47 & Basildon 08 and 38

Service 6A Monday to Friday peak Woodcutters to Leigh Station – Withdrawn by Arriva

But 'Stephensons' to take over

3 morning journeys down to station remain

7 evening journeys from station to Woodcutters reduced to 5, with first journey 1649 withdrawn

But one journey 1851 ex Station to West Leigh Schools

Woodcutters to Leigh Tuesday Shoppers Service ½ hourly 1000 to 1400 retained plus new similar service on Thursdays

Trains – Mon to Friday peak trains revised by 3 minutes with new West Ham stop
