  - a. **The Mencap Christmas Concert** on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> December at Highlands Methodist Church. This very well supported event (24 Members plus 4 helpers and drivers attended) was thoroughly enjoyed by everyone.
  - b. **Cinderella** on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2013 (matinee) at the Cliffs Pavilion. There was slightly less support for this year's pantomime with 22 members plus 4 helpers and drivers attending. Feedback was mixed. Members were less enthusiastic about the modern songs and dance included in what they expected to be a largely traditional pantomime. However everyone thought the 3D glasses were great fun and the effects brilliant.
  - c. **The Cranleigh Quintet** on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> February at the Plaza Centre. This quintet cancelled at the last minute and were replaced by the Atea Quintet. The classical enthusiasts within our group thoroughly enjoyed a varied programme performed by the five young musicians. Numbers attending (11 including helpers) were down because of cancellations (3) through cold and coughs in the winter period.
