RE: East of England Permit Scheme

As you will be aware, Southend Borough Council has been preparing to operate a permit scheme under Part 3 of the Traffic Management Act 2004. The Secretary of State approved the East of England Permit Scheme in June this year and has now made an Order under section 34(4) and (5) and 39(2) of that Act for the Scheme to commence operation on 5th November 2012. As required by Regulation 17(1) of The Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007, I hereby inform you that the East of England Permit Scheme (*the Scheme*) will start operation on 5th November 2012 (00:01).

The approved Scheme describing the types of works or activities for which, and type of roads on which, permits will be required, and all other details of the Scheme including the processes for applying for permits and the level of permits fees and when and by whom they are payable, can be found on the East of England Permit Scheme website:

From 5th November 2012 promoters of all works or activities specified in the Scheme as requiring a permit must obtain such a permit from Southend Borough Council before starting work on the highway. Working without a permit or working in contravention of conditions attached to a permit is an offence, and in such circumstances, a promoter may be subject to a fixed penalty notice issued by the Council. Promoters should refer to Section 24 of the Scheme for details of the transitional arrangements that will apply.

C2C YEAR-END RAILWAY CLOSURE

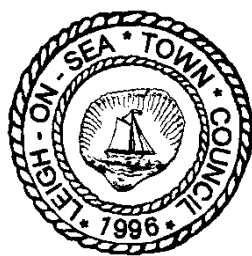
Advance notice that after the last train on Christmas Eve, the railway line will be closed between Leigh-on-Sea and Pitsea for several days.

This is due to the replacement of the bridge at Benfleet. The closure will continue until at least 31st December, but may extend for some days due to the weather conditions. Commencing on Thursday 27th December and until the end of the closure a replacement bus service will operate between Leigh and Pitsea.

However, rail passengers wishing to travel to and from London during the closure period may find it easier to travel on the railway line between Southend Victoria and Liverpool Street.
