12. LICENCE APPLICATION

a) Irma's Restaurant, 9-13 Elm Road, Leigh

Application for a new Premises Licence to supply alcohol for consumption on and off premises daily from 10:00 until midnight. The provision of regulated entertainment comprising recorded music daily from 10:00 until 01:00 the following day. The provision of late night refreshment daily until 01:00 the following day.

The premises will be run in two parts. The front part will operate predominately as restaurant with waiter/waitress services to tables only. The rear part will operate predominately as a cocktail bar serving both food and drinks.

Objection on the grounds of Public Nuisance (Disturbance to Neighbouring Properties). The Sub-Committee felt the Alcohol licensing hours should be from 10.00 until 23.00 except for Friday and Saturday 10.00 until Midnight. The provision of recorded music and late night refreshment should run an hour later until midnight and 01.00 respectively.

Additionally the Sub-Committee recommended the installation of a noise limiter to minimise disturbance.
